Instructors

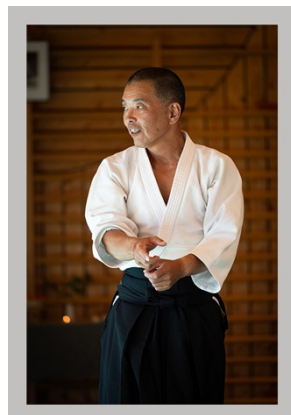
